## Beginner's Stained Glass Courses

Our specially designed beginner's class panels teach the student all of the cuts used in stained glass, and also introduces you to simplified framing and working with bevels. The overall design is simple, yet elegant and is sure to fit into any existing decor. Of course, the student selects their own colors so each project is individual.

The course content for our three-session class is comprehensive and each week's instruction is built upon the prior week's instruction, so students must attend all sessions. Classes are kept small to increase the ease of interaction between students and instructor. Students are encouraged to ask questions throughout the course.

We include the use of all necessary tools for all of our classes and workshops. During these classes, all students will have the opportunity to use the studio's soldering irons, glass grinders, glass cutters, hand tools and more.




## “A Night Out of the House” Club
